Announcement.

The Association of West Midland Motor Clubs will organise a Regional Association Championship known as the **"Association of West Midland Motor Clubs Road Rally Championship 2010"**.

The championship will be held under the General Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations, and any written instructions that the Series Administrator may issue.

The Series Administrator reserves the right to alter and amend these championship regulations in accordance with D11 of the MSA yearbook.

The Series Administrator has the powers of an Organiser specifically as under D25.1.9, D25.1.10, D25.1.16, and D25.1.17, of the MSA yearbook.

Results and bulletins will be issued at regular intervals throughout the season. Any bulletins will carry the power of these S.Rs in accordance with D11 of the MSA yearbook.

Competitors have seven days from the receipt of results to make a query, after which they will become final, unless any query or protest leads to a change of the results, after which a further seven days will elapse before the results become final.

Should there be a dispute between a Championship Contender and an organising club, other than those matters to be decided by the Stewards of the meeting, this dispute may be referred by either party to the Championship Stewards listed within the yearbook, whose decision will be final.

Event Organisers Regulations.

All events within the championship calendar **MUST** be of **National B status**.

All AWMMC affiliated clubs are entitled to apply to the Series Administrator for an event to be included in the championship. Clubs may submit more than 1 event, however only 1 event will be used.

On publication of regulations a set must be sent to the Series Administrator, by post or Email.

Final instructions and an entry list must be sent to the Series Administrator in the week prior to the event-taking place, by post or Email.

A final entry list and a full set of results must be sent to the Series Administrator within seven days of the event-taking place, by post or Email.

All event Entry Forms must allow space for contenders to signify entry in the Championship and Championship Registration Number.

The Series Administrator must be informed at the earliest possible time giving notification of cancellation.

General.

The number of Qualifying events will be decided by the Series Administrator.

If through **Force Majeure** any event dates are altered or cancelled, the Series Administrator reserves the right to accept a change of date, cancel that particular qualifying event and alter the number of events which score points (as per D 11), but, **NO** substitute events will be used.

Any changes will be given to all Championship Contenders as soon as it is deemed possible.

Postponement does not carry automatic retention of Championship status.

Bulletins issued by the Series Administrator during the year will have the same authority as those within the current yearbook.

Competitors Information.

It is the competitors responsibility to obtain regulations for each individual event.

The Series Administrator will not be responsible for any entries refused.

The Championship is open to all fully paid up members of any Motor Club affiliated to the AWMMC.

A registration fee of £10.00 per contender payable to "AWMMC" **must** be paid before any points will be awarded.

Registration for the Championship will close at midnight on the 30TH June 2010.

No points can be claimed retrospectively.

Competitors must register in either the Drivers or Navigators Championship to score points.

It is not necessary for a Driver and Navigator to remain as a team throughout the duration of the season.

Contenders must state that they are Championship Contenders on any entry form of any event by quoting their registration number.

Championship decals will be provided, by the Series Administrator upon completion of registration.

Final Championship positions in Overall, Class(1ST), under 1425 cc and Class(2ND,3RD), will be issued within fifteen days of the results of the final event.

Competitors will then have fifteen days in which to query the Final Results.

The Championship Results will then be deemed to be true and correct and under no circumstances will be altered.

In order to **Collect Championship Trophies** at the end of the season, **all** competitors are required to marshal /organise on at least one event throughout the year, and score points by competing on a minimum of 2 events.

Marshalling only counts on events that appear in the AWMMC Qualifying events list. (See below).

A competitor is not allowed to **compete** and **marshall** on the same event..

Championship Marshalling cards **must** be signed by a senior event official (i.e., Chief Marshal) as proof of marshalling and **returned** to the Series Administrator within 7 days of the last event taking place.

Any contender involved in organising a Championship event may claim marshalling points for that event.

The AWMMC has appointed a series Scrutineer who will act as "Judge of Fact" as to the compliance with both the letter and the spirit of the definitions of the MSA Technical Regulations.

Contenders are advised that Scrutineers may check at any event the eligibility of any vehicles. Therefore, contenders must provide a method of sealing the engine if they do not wish to be checked for cubic capacity until later in the season. Any contender found to have an illegal vehicle or removing the seal that the Scrutineer has applied, will forfeit all Championship points gained to that time. All cost of scrutiny is the responsibility of the contender.

Eligible Vehicles.

Any Two Wheel Drive vehicle that conforms to current MSA Road Rally Vehicle Regulations are allowed.

FOUR WHEELDRIVE AND/OR TURBOCHARGED VEHICLES WILL **NOT** BE ALLOWED IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP.

All vehicles must be presented in a Clean and Tidy condition as befits the nature of the sport / championship.

Awards.

Any perpetual awards will remain the property of the AWMCC and must be returned to the SA or an AWMCC Officer on demand at the expense of the holder. These awards are to be kept in good condition and the holder is responsible for their safekeeping.

1 st Overall Driver & Navigator	An Award

Highest placed Driver and Navigator under the age of 21 years at 1/1/2010. An award.

To qualify for 1ST overall a competitor must compete on a minimum of 2 Welsh based events and 2 East Midland based events.

To qualify for 1ST in class (expert, semi, novice) and "under 1425cc" a competitor must compete on 1 Welsh based event and 1 East Midland based event.

Welsh based events - Bala & DMC, Barcud MC, Dovey Valley MC, Knighton MC, Teifi Valley MC and Welsh Border CC.

East Midlands based events - Lindeholme MSC, Matlock MC, Mercia Motor Sports, Mid-Derbyshire MC, Sheffield & Hallamshire MC and Stockport 061 MC.

Class Structure.

Drivers & Navigators

- A** Expert Having finished in the top ten of a "National B" status road rally on 3 separate occasions.
- B** Semi-Expert Having finished outside the top ten, but in the top 25 of a "National B" status road rally on 3 separate occasions.
- C** Novice Having never achieved the above results.

A contender will maintain the status declared on the Championship registration form for the current season.

Once a competitor has achieved Expert or Semi - Expert finishes on 3 separate occasions, he / she will automatically move up to that class the following season.

Events to Score.

There will be 15 designated events within the 2010 championship calendar.

A competitor will score best 8 out of the first 10 events competed on.

Points Structure.

Overall Placing	1 st o/a registered AWMMC contender	100 points
	2 nd o/a registered AWMMC contender	95 points
	3 rd o/a registered AWMMC contender	90 points

Then decreasing by two points per registered contender per place.

A Registered Contender will be awarded an extra 5 points for an outright Event win.

In addition, if a contender starts but does not finish an event, 10 points will be awarded, this is mainly to show in the results sheet when a competitor has taken part in an event.

In the event of a tie between two or more contenders, the contender who has gained the most points first will be deemed the Winner or by other means deemed to be fair.
