This championship will be held under the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these supplementary regulations.

The championship is organised for drivers who must be members of a member club of the AWMMC.

The number of qualifying events will be decided by the Championship Secretary and all clubs affiliated to the AWMMC are entitled to apply to the secretary of the Association to have their event(s) included in the Championship for the following year.

Regulations MUST be sent to all registered Championship contenders and a list of these will be available from the Championship Secretary.

A copy of the regulations issued for each event MUST be sent to the Championship Secretary as soon they are published. A copy of the final entry list and a copy of the results MUST be forwarded within seven days of the event taking place.

**ELIGIBILITY** The Championship is open to all registered contenders (who must be members of a club who is an association member)  
All competitors will be required to hold a valid Motorsport UK Competition licence  
All classes for the Championship will be as designated by the event organisers in the supplementary regulations for each event.

**REGISTRATION** Competitors wishing to register for the Championship should

**SCORING** Points will be awarded on Class Positions as follows  
1<sup>st</sup> in Class 10 points  
2<sup>nd</sup> in Class 9 points  
3<sup>rd</sup> in Class 8 points etc.  
If there are less than 4 starters in the class, then the points will be reduced by one.  
All starters will receive a minimum of 1 point.  
Tie Breakers will be resolved by taking the competitor with the greatest number of 1<sup>st</sup> in class and 2<sup>nd</sup> in class and so on until the tie is resolved.  
The winner will be the competitor with the highest total points from 6 events.

**AWARDS** Trophies will be awarded to the highest scoring drivers in the championship. The number of trophies will be dependent on the number of registered entrants.


5 or less entrants – highest scorer only

Between 6 & 12 entrants – runner up trophy will be awarded.

Over 12 entrants – 3<sup>rd</sup> place trophy will be awarded.

**EVENTS** There will be a spread of Trials in the AWMMC Region.  
The Championship will comprise of 14 events with a competitors best six results to count. If three or more events fail to run, then the number of qualifying rounds will be reduced by the same number of events etc.
