Change to Article 9- Championship Stewards

The list of Officials listed Online should read 'Eric Cowcill, Brian Hemmings, Barry Guess, Dave Lucas and Bill Pardoe' This has now been corrected in the Published Regulations and now matches what was sent to Motorsport UK when applying for the Championship Permit.

The profile of the Heart of England championship has increased since the entries have opened. This improved profile has led to an increase in the amount of people and companies wishing to associate themselves with the championship, which we are very grateful for.
