8. TRAINING OFFICER'S REPORT:

Training for Wales Rally GB will be held at a Rally site, in Wales, sometime during the last two week-ends in September.

On-Line Training for Marshals: A number of "old hands" will fail to get registration unless they complete the MSA on-line system and will be de-registered in 2017.

9. REGIONAL MEETING:

John Arnold reported that the meeting is being held on Wednesday 17th August 2016.

Items of relevance from the Rallies Committee include:-

- a) Safety car requirements from 2017. Dates to follow.
- b) Refuelling - there is to be NO RANDOM REFUELLING PERMITTED ON EVENTS.
- c) Vehicle tracking - getting closer to a decision for 2017.
- d) Medical checks - testing at a younger age to be considered.
- e) Training modules for 2017 / 18.

The Chairman then handed to meeting over to Sue Sanders - MSA

Sue continued by showing a short video, with regards to safety - particularly with regards to Wales Rally GB. Videos will be made available to clubs shortly.

The Chairman thanked Sue for her contributions to the meeting and then handed over to Jonathan Day - MSA Director of Development & Training

Jonathan opened by explaining that he had been with MSA for approximately eight months now following a number of years with the governing body for cycling in the UK.

- a) Go Motorsport - he hoped to offer training for young drivers, through schools etc..
- b) Rally Future meetings - Six have been held so far with an average attendance of 60 – 80 at each.
- c) Marshals Accreditation - this provides stability. Approx. 4500 have registered.
- d) National Resources Wales - on going matter
- e) MSA will launch their search for Club/Volunteer of the Year in September for eight weeks.
- f) Club Development Fund - more clarity on what is covered by the funding in 2017.
- g) Rescue & Recovery Units - funding is still available.
- h) Anti-Doping - how does it work? Is random testing carried out? ON GOING
- i) Closed Roads - on going case.
- j) MSA clothing - on going review into this.

11. TREASURY REPORT:

- c) A new “Standard, road-going” Class has been introduced both at Curborough & Shenstone events. Shenstone MC propose the formal introduction of a “Road Car” class in 2017.
- d) It was reported that the costs involved in motorsport are, generally speaking, tending to be prohibitive for encouraging new competitors.
